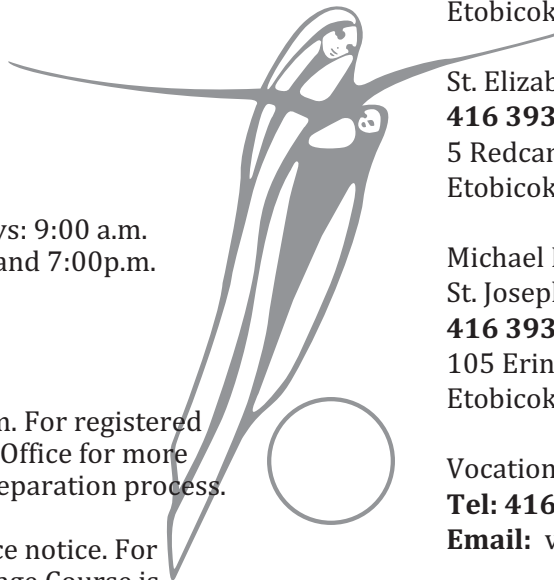

HOLY WEEK AND THE EASTER TRIDUUM

Holy Week is the week which precedes the great feast of the Resurrection of our Lord on Easter Sunday. Holy Week includes the last days of Lent and the beginning of the Easter Triduum. During Holy Week the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life on earth. Holy Week begins with the celebration of Passion Sunday also known as Palm Sunday. Palm Sunday celebrates the regal entrance of Our Lord into Jerusalem, where he will face his bitter Passion for us sinners. During Holy Week there is celebration of the Mass of Chrism. In the Archdiocese of Toronto, this celebration takes place on the Tuesday of the Holy Week in the Cathedral. The Auxiliary bishops and the priests gather around the Archbishop to express the unity of the priesthood and Christ's one Sacrifice. At the Chrism Mass priests renew their commitment to serve. The consecration of the Oil of Chrism and the blessing of Oil of the Sick and Oil of Catechumen is incorporated in the celebration of the Chrism Mass. The colour of the vestments is white.

The Easter Triduum begins in the evening of Holy Thursday when we celebrate the Mass of the Last Supper. We celebrate the three gifts that Jesus imparted to his beloved Bride the Church: the Priesthood, the Eucharist and a love that is stronger than death. The Evening Mass of the Last Supper usually includes the ceremony of the Washing of the Feet. The Mass of the Last Supper always ends with Solemn Transfer of the Eucharist to the place of Reposition. The colour of the vestments is white.

The Easter Triduum continues on the following day commonly referred to as Good Friday. The Church celebrates the Passion and the death of her Lord. We call "good" this day when our Lord loved us and gave himself up for us, redeeming us from sin and death. The celebration of the Passion and death of our Lord usually takes place at the customary ninth hour - 3PM. The celebration includes the veneration of the Cross by the faithful and the distribution of Holy Communion that was consecrated at the Mass of the Last Supper. The colour of the vestments is red.

The Easter Vigil is the high point of the Christian year, the celebration of the Paschal Mystery in the great Easter Eucharist, summit and source of the liturgical action and life of God's people. The full meaning of the Easter Vigil is a waiting for the Lord. He who took our human flesh, who suffered and died for us in that flesh, now rises in that same human body, glorified and immortal, as befits the new life of resurrection. The celebration of the Easter Vigil moves through four distinctive stages: the Solemn Beginning of the Vigil and the Service of Light, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of Baptism (if any) and Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Easter candle also known as Paschal candle is the central symbolic object in the celebration of the Vigil liturgy because it represents the risen Lord in his glory. The colour of vestments is white.
