

This Sunday January 14, 2018 is the Second Sunday in

Ordinary Time. The Solemnity of Epiphany January 7, replaced the First Sunday in Ordinary Time and the week following the Solemnity of Epiphany is therefore the First Week in Ordinary Time. The Season of Ordinary Time also known as the Season of the Year will end on the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday February 14, for the Seasons of Lent and Easter. Ordinary Time continues on the Monday after the Solemnity of Pentecost Sunday May 20. The Season of Ordinary Time is the longest of the seasons of the liturgical calendar with thirty four Sundays and the same number of weeks. The Thirty-Fourth Sunday is the last Sunday in Ordinary Time and it is celebrated as the Solemnity of Christ the King. The Thirty-Fourth week ends the Ordinary Time and a new liturgical year and a new season, Advent begins. The Church Year is structured around the life of Jesus. During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus. The Church asks the faithful to meditate on Jesus at all times and in all circumstances and to attend the

celebration of the Holy Eucharist especially on

Sundays. The liturgical colour for the Season of the Year is green on Sundays and ferial days. As we are in

the liturgical year Cycle B, we shall read the Gospel of

Mark on most of the Sundays in Ordinary Time.


