



#### **THE SEASON OF LENT**

We begin the season of Lent on Ash Wednesday, February 14. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of our own faith journey in Lent, forty days to prepare spiritually to celebrate Easter. The Sundays of this time of the year are called the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent. The Sixth Sunday of which Holy Week begins, is called "Palm Sunday" or "Passion Sunday". To understand the spiritual meaning of Lent, it is important to reflect on the words of the minister when blessed ashes are imposed on us: either 'Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return" or "Repent and believe in the Gospel. These words form the heart of our Lenten discipline, reminding us of our mortal nature, weakness and brokenness and also of our call to return to the Lord with heart renewed. During the season of Lent, the Church encourages the faithful to attend Mass especially on Sundays, to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, to pray often, and to do some acts of charity. When we strive to journey through Lent pondering spiritual things and with our hearts open to the Holy Spirit, our Lenten discipline may help us experience the love and mercy of God in our lives and in the lives of others. By the end of Lent, hopefully we will have made some significant changes in our spiritual lives.

The colour of Lent is purple- a sign of penitential character of the Season.


