

The Season of Advent

Today we begin a new liturgical year, Cycle C. We also begin the Season of Advent as the First Sunday of Advent. We begin a period of waiting for the Lord's coming as we reflect on the peace, hope, joy and love that comes with his First Coming as Jesus born Emmanuel-God with us. The Season of Advent shares some features with the Season of Lent-the penitential nature characterized by the purple/violet color of the vestments, the omission of the Gloria at Sunday Mass and the moderation of the use of flowers around the altar. The penitential nature of the Season of Advent invites us to embark on our Advent "discipline" as a means of reflecting on the state of our spiritual relationship with God and neighbor. The Season of Advent offers us a new beginning and a new hope to live and act as people to be ready and awake for the Second Coming of our Lord. This is the time to offer support and to help each other in joyful anticipation of the coming of Christmas Day.
