

The Season of Lent

After the Season of Christmas and a few weeks in the Season of Ordinary Time, the Church calendar brings us to the Season of Lent on Ash Wednesday. The Season of Lent is described as the "acceptable time" and "the day of salvation"-a time of spiritual renewal, a time to return to the Lord.

On Ash Wednesday with ashes on our foreheads we may express with enthusiasm our eagerness to embark on the Lenten "disciplines"-to pray often, to go to Mass often, to go to Confession, to do the Stations of the Cross, to fast and to give alms. However, it is important that we understand the spiritual significance of any discipline and to do it with a right attitude. So, as we begin the journey of Lent, here are a couple of questions to focus on our Lenten "discipline". What is the reason behind any Lenten "discipline" that we plan to accomplish? How do we see Christ in the plan?

Our various Lenten "disciplines" may help us to learn to follow in the footsteps of Jesus who for his great love for us "emptied himself and became obedient to the point of death-even death on a cross" (Phil. 2:7-8). The popular discipline of Lent-giving up something for the sake of others is deeply rooted in stewardship if we do it with "a renewed spirit and a contrite heart". When we allow ourselves to be led by the Spirit, our journey with Christ will help us experience the mercy and compassion of our Lord as we help each other spiritually prepare to celebrate the glorious feast of Easter.
