

St ShareLife

ShareLife would like to thank you for your generosity to the 2018 Campaign as shared in the letter below. As we start to plan for the 2019 Campaign, ShareLife would like to give you an update of this years' campaign.

"In 2019, the ShareLife Advisory Board and Trustees have set a parish campaign goal of \$13.8 million, an increase of \$440,000 over our 2018 campaign result. The goal has been set high to address the needs of the agencies and to plan for the long term expansion and development of new and existing programs and services. The ShareLife office continues to maintain a cost ratio of less than 11%, ensuring the maximum amount possible is dedicated to the work of the agencies.

This year, ShareLife will be taking over the funding to three agencies that they previously received funding from the United Way in Peel (in 2017, we did the same for agencies that were receiving funding from the United Way in York Region.) For 2019, this will result in an increase in allocations of \$460,000, rising to over \$600,000 in 2020. Thus, it will be important that we achieve an increased campaign in 2019 to cover these new allocations.

We thank you in advance for your support as we work to grow the ShareLife campaign and achieve greater support for our agencies in the year ahead!"
