

HOLY WEEK AND EASTER TRIDUUM

Holy Week begins with the celebration of Passion Sunday also known as Palm Sunday. Palm Sunday celebrates the regal entrance of Our Lord into Jerusalem, where he will face his bitter Passion. During Holy Week the Church celebrates "the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life on earth". In the Archdiocese of Toronto, we celebrate the Mass of the Chrism presided by Cardinal Collins with the Auxiliary Bishops and priests of the Archdiocese concelebrating on Tuesday of Holy Week at the Basilica of St. Michael. At this Mass, priests renew their commitment to serve, there is consecration of the Oil of Chrism and the blessing of the Oil of the Sick and Oil of Catechumen.

The Easter Triduum is part of the Holy Week and this period comprises Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. During this three-day period, Mother Church "solemnly celebrates the greatest mysteries of our redemption, keeping by means of special celebrations the memorial of her Lord, crucified, buried and risen". On Holy Thursday we celebrate the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. At this celebration, the Church reenacts all that took place "on the night that Jesus was betrayed": the institution of the Holy Eucharist by Jesus, the gift of the priesthood and our call to serve each other symbolized by Jesus washing the feet of his disciples. On Good Friday we celebrate the Passion and death of our Lord. On Holy Saturday we celebrate the Easter Vigil Mass. The Easter Vigil is considered "the high point of the Christian year". The Easter Vigil celebration foretells of the light of hope of Easter. The Vigil leads us into the celebration of Easter Sunday.

The celebration of the Easter Triduum helps us to understand the deeper meaning of the Passion, death and the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. It also helps us to understand our own journey of faith as Christians and to ponder the events leading to our redemption. The Church encourages the faithful to participate in the celebration of the Easter Triduum liturgies.
