# Ascension of the Lord Joy is the Mission; Love is the Message

Pope Francis begins his 2013 Apostolic Exhortation *Evangelii Gaudium* (The Joy of the Gospel) with these words: "The joy of the Gospel fills the hearts of all who encounter Jesus." In this document the Pope encourages the Christian faithful to "embark upon a new chapter of evangelization marked by this joy, while pointing out new paths for the Church's journey in years to come". He calls Christians to be missionary disciples to proclaim the Good News.

Our call to be missionary disciples is related to the celebration of the Ascension of the Lord. The readings at today's liturgy describe the Ascension event and what it means to us. In today's Gospel reading, Luke has connected the Ascension event to the events of the resurrection and that of giving of the Spirit in such a way that the Ascension can only be understood in the light of giving of the Holy Spirit. The departure of Jesus to his Father comes with his promise of sending the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. Through the Holy Spirit, the disciples will be empowered to become witnesses to Christ.

Today's celebration reminds us that as Christians we have been called to continue with the mission entrusted to the first disciples to preach the Good News. When we strive to live the Gospel by caring for the poor, bringing joy to the sorrowful, promoting peace, bringing healing to those who are wounded and supporting those in need, we proclaim the Good News and we help bring the love of Christ to others. Let us open our hearts to the Holy Spirit so that we may live as grateful and cheerful stewards.
