The Season of Ordinary Time

The celebration of the Solemnity of Pentecost Sunday brought the Season of Easter to an end. The Monday after Pentecost Sunday begins Week 10 in Ordinary Time.

The season of Ordinary Time is the longest of the seasons of the liturgical calendar with thirty-four Sundays and the same number of weeks. The Thirty-Fourth Sunday is the last Sunday in Ordinary Time and it is celebrated as the Solemnity of Christ the King. The Thirty-Fourth week ends the Ordinary Time and a new liturgical year and a new season, Advent begins. First Sunday of Advent is December 01, 2019.

The Church Year is structured around the life of Jesus. During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus. The Church asks us to meditate on Jesus at all times and in all circumstances and to attend the celebration of the Holy Eucharist especially on Sundays. The colour for Ordinary Time is green.

Students can bring their artwork to Monsignor Percy Johnson Hall just before the 11 am Mass. After Mass, there will be a reception in the Hall. Parents and guardians are encouraged to attend the 11 am Mass and the party with their children. Come and have fun to celebrate the end of the 2018-19 academic year.



June 2019 Update

Our parish has received the 6th payment distribution from the Family of Faith. Since inception, we have received a total of \$90,557.55. Half of that amount, \$45,278.77, has been evenly applied to reduce our "Celebrating the Legacy" Capital Campaign loan and our Archdiocesan Debt. The other half has been used for the projects outlined in the original Family of Faith case statement and described in previous bulletin updates.

The \$4,196.88 received in May was used to reduce the advance taken from Family of Faith for the rectory repairs completed in late 2017 and 2018. Future distributions will continue to be applied to the advance, currently at \$32,882.41, until it is reduced to zero.

The parish and the Archdiocese appreciate the continuing fulfillment of your Family of Faith pledges which support completed and ongoing projects. Thank you for your generosity!

Significant wall crack repairs and painting were completed in the Church front entrance, the choir loft, the new votive candle shrine, and the altar servers' and priests' sacristies. Moisture damage to walls in the Church hall and in the rectory basement were also repaired and painted. Plumbing repairs included the repair/replacement of leaking taps, seized shut off valves, rusted p-traps, snaking to unclog two drains and the installation of new shut off valves for sinks and toilets where required.

With the help of your generous donations, we are continuing to focus on regular maintenance of our Church, hall kitchen and rectory. There are two collections remaining – one on September 8/19 and the other on December 1/19.
