DO YOU KNOW THAT.....

The days throughout the Liturgical Year are given varying ranks of observance. **Sunday** is the first day of the liturgical week. It is the primordial Christian feast, the weekly paschal celebration observed by the Universal Church according to apostolic tradition. The Creed is said or sung at Mass on all Sundays and the Gloria is said or sung on Sundays except on Sundays in Advent and Lent.

Solemnities are regarded as the most important days in the liturgical calendar. They celebrate a mystery of faith, the life of Jesus and his mother or another important saint. Examples of Solemnities are Christmas and The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The celebration of Sunday gives way only to Solemnities or Feasts of the Lord except during the Seasons of Advent, Lent and Easter. Therefore, the Solemnities or the Feasts of the Lord that fall on these Sundays are observed on another day. The Gloria and the Creed are said or sung on Solemnities. Solemnities have Evening Prayers on the evening of the day before. Some Solemnities also have their own Vigil Mass celebrated on the evening of the day before.

Feasts are lower in ranking to Solemnities. Feast days are confined only to the natural day. Examples of Feast are the Baptism of our Lord and in Canada the Feast of the Canadian Martyrs. Feasts do not have Evening Prayers on the evening of the day before and they do not have Vigil Mass. The Gloria is said or sung at Mass on Feast Days. The Creed is not said or sung. When a Feast of the Lord occurs on a Sunday in Ordinary Time or in the Christmas Season, the Feast replaces the particular Sunday Mass.

Memorials are of lesser importance and they are either obligatory or optional. They commemorate saints for example the Memorial of Marguerite Bourgeoys. The Gloria and the Creed are not said or sung at Mass. Obligatory Memorials that fall on the weekdays of Lent may be commemorated as optional Memorial and Optional Memorials are omitted. When two or more optional Memorials occur on the same day, only one is to be celebrated in the Mass. Ferial is a weekday on which there is no special celebration.




