

"Faithful and Ready - Living in the Light of the Promise"

Today's readings invite us into a deeper understanding of what it means to live with faith, to live with hope, and to live with readiness.

Faith Is Our Foundation

In the second reading from the Letter to the Hebrews, we are given a powerful definition:

"Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." Abraham believed in God's promise even when it seemed impossible. He left everything familiar, not knowing where he was going. He trusted even when the road was unclear. And he was even willing to offer his only son, Isaac, believing that God could raise the dead. That's the kind of faith God is calling us to — a faith that trusts God even when we don't have all the answers, a faith that steps forward when logic tells us to stay back. How often in our lives are we tempted to wait until we "see" before we act? But real faith moves before it sees. Real faith says, "God has spoken, and that's enough."

A Call to Be Ready

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us: "Be dressed for action and have your lamps lit." We live in a world of distractions. It's easy to get caught up in the busyness of life — work, family responsibilities, technology, entertainment — and forget that we are waiting for the Master to return. But Jesus says: "You must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour." This isn't meant to frighten us — it's an invitation to live with purpose, with awareness, and with joy. Being ready doesn't mean being fearful — it means living each day as if it matters, because it does. It means living with hearts focused on eternal things, not temporary treasures. As Jesus reminds us: "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." So let's ask ourselves — where is my treasure? Is it in wealth, reputation, comfort? Or is it in generosity, love, service, and truth?

The first reading reminds us that even our ancestors found joy in trusting God's promises. Even in secret and in danger, they sang songs of praise and trusted in the covenant. And they were delivered. We are their spiritual descendants. Their legacy is not meant to be admired but continued. They remind us that God is always working — even in the darkest night, even in uncertainty, God is faithful.

Live each day with active faith — trust God with your future, even when it's unclear. Live each day with spiritual readiness — keep your heart awake and your hands busy in love. Live each day as a faithful steward — using your gifts, your time, and your presence to build up the kingdom. Don't wait for the "right moment" to begin living fully for God — that moment is now. Let us walk like Abraham, who didn't know where he was going but trusted anyway. Let us serve like faithful stewards, alert and ready. Let us fix our hearts on heaven — on the city God has prepared for us. And when the Master returns, may He find us watching, serving, and loving — ready to enter the joy of the kingdom.

Please note that a request for a letter of reference may not be fulfilled if the pastor lacks sufficient familiarity with the individual making the request.
