

### **COVID-19 Safety Protocols in Churches**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the safety protocols in place, there are a few changes in the parish.

Admittance to all Masses will be given to those who come first. There is no reservation of seats. Doors open 30 minutes before Mass starts. Please note that due to physical distancing in place, the seating capacity of the church is drastically reduced. COVID-19 safety protocols are strictly observed. Facemask or a face covering is mandatory in the church. Please remember that respecting provincial recommendations, we do not come to church if we have a fever, cough, difficulty in breathing, sore throat or we are not feeling well.

### Archdiocese of Toronto Stewardship Sunday

In Cardinal Collins' Pastoral Letter on Stewardship he wrote, "Each of us spends a brief time in this life, preparing for our eternal life with God. While we are here, we receive everything from God, even life itself, and are asked to make good use of what God has entrusted to us. We are invited by God to be good stewards of his gifts. It is no wonder that the idea of stewardship plays such a central role in the life of the faith."

In an effort to affirm all the wonderful ways people enrich parish life with the sharing of their time and talents through love of God and neighbour, Cardinal Collins has instituted Stewardship Sunday as an annual occurrence across the entire Archdiocese on the 25<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time. As such, the first Stewardship Sunday is on September 20, 2020.

The Cardinal has said that stewardship is undeniably fruitful. "Where, over time, more and more parishioners become engaged in committing their time, talent, and treasure to the work of the Gospel, the Church flourishes." ## THE CANADA EMERGENCY WAGE SUBSIDY (CEWS)

As a result of the Archdiocese's application to the federal government, Our Lady of Peace Parish has received the CEWS benefit in the amount of \$29,262 for the period March - August 2020. The receipt of this benefit has allowed us to pay our staff as some worked from home from the start of the COVID-19 restrictions and during their modified return to work under the Stage 3 guidelines of the provincial government and the Archdiocese. We have now been advised that the CEWS will end in December 2020 and that the wage subsidy will be significantly reduced each month between September and December.

The parish sincerely thanks all parishioners who have continued to support the parish by bringing their Offertory envelopes and their donations to Mass, by dropping off or mailing their regular Offertory envelope donations, and for all donations made through Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG), Donate Now and on-line banking. Your donations have helped us to cover the other operating costs of the parish during this difficult time. Let us continue to support our parish.
