## **The Season of Advent 2020**



The new Church's liturgical year, Year B begins with the celebration of the First Sunday of Advent on November 29th. We begin our faith journey through four Sundays to prepare for the birth of Jesus. Due to Advent's penitential nature, traditionally, we embark on Advent "discipline"which prepares us for Christmas. The spirituality of the two comings of Christ-Christmas and The Second Coming of Christ-- calls us to embrace holiness. The twofold nature of Advent means that we need to take into consideration how we live so that we are mindful of the teaching of Jesus, "to keep alert for you do not know when the master of the house will come" (Mark 13.33-37). We can begin our Advent journey with the examination of our on-going relationship with God and neighbour. We can also reflect on the many ways in which we can transform our lives to become closer to God.

With the lockdown and the increasing numbers of new infections, we can still be creative in making the celebration of Advent more meaningful to us. The traditional spiritual exercises such as praying often; doing the Scripture readings for the day's Mass; being patient, keeping ourselves and others safe, showing gratitude to those who care for us and learning to reach out to those in need through our support of the parishes' outreach programs are still available to us. They are all activities that bring us closer to God and to each other and help us grow in charity.

As we begin Advent, let us reflect on how the light of the Advent candles-- symbolizing hope, love, joy and peace-light the path of our Advent journey. Have a spirit-filled Advent.
