### **THE SEASON OF EASTER**

Easter is the "Feast of Feasts", the "Solemnity of all Solemnities" and the "Great Sunday". The celebration of Easter begins the Season of Easter. Sundays of Easter Season have precedence over all feasts of the Lord and Solemnities. The Easter Season recalls the time when the risen Lord manifested himself to the disciples and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles at Pentecost Sunday. During this season, the Easter candle is lit for all Masses. Again and again, the liturgy resounds with the cry of "alleluia!" as the people reborn through the Paschal Mystery wait in joyful hope for the day when they too will share the glory of their risen Lord. During the Easter season, the colour of the vestments and the antependium is white. The Church encourages the faithful to participate in the celebration of the Eucharist on Sundays of the Season of Easter. Pentecost Sunday concludes the season of Easter.
