

Pentecost Sunday - May 23, 2021

This weekend we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. We celebrate the birth of the Church and also the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Church. We usually associate Pentecost with the call to serve as people baptized in the Holy Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit who empowers us to live as servants through our acts of service. Every year the celebration of Pentecost Sunday offers us a challenge for self-reflection: to look into our hearts and judge the generosity of our service to people around us. Our generosity to others is our selfless act of love. Our acts of love can be the expression of our response to God's love, the love revealed in Jesus' Death and Resurrection.

This year, let us use the opportunity to reexamine the many ways in which we can serve. Our gifts of service may be different but the source of strength of the gifts of service is the same for every person -- the Holy Spirit. Our different gifts of service to others bring us closer to God and to each other and create loving communities. The celebration of Pentecost Sunday brings the Season of Easter to an end. As we enter into Ordinary Time, let us ask God to kindle the fire of his Spirit in our hearts so we can live as one joyful people united in and inspired by one Spirit.

THE SEASON OF ORDINARY TIME LITURGICAL YEAR B

The Season of Ordinary Time of the Liturgical Year B began on Monday after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on Sunday, January 10, 2021. The Feast of the Lord's Baptism on Sunday, January 10 served as the First Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Ordinary Time continued until Tuesday February 16, 2021. Ash Wednesday February 17 led us into the Season of Lent.

The Season of Ordinary Time resumes on the Monday, May 24, 2021 after the celebration of Pentecost Sunday on May 23, 2021. The Season of Ordinary Time is the longest of the Liturgical Seasons with thirty-four Sundays and weeks. The Thirty-Fourth Sunday is the last Sunday in Ordinary Time and it is celebrated as the Solemnity of Christ the King. The Thirty-Fourth week ends the Ordinary Time. A new Liturgical Year C begins with the Season of Advent.

"The Liturgical Year is structured to help us celebrate and understand the spiritual significance of the mysteries of Jesus. During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. The Church encourages the faithful to participate in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist especially on Sundays which are Holydays of Obligation." The liturgical colour for Ordinary Time is green.
