The provincial government has announced that Ontario moves to Step 3 of the

"Roadmap for Reopening" plan on Friday, July 16, 2021.

We have received some guidelines from the Archdiocese for implementation as of July 16, 2021.

One of the guidelines concerning our churches is:

"For sacramental celebrations, in Step 3, there is no capacity limit for places of worship.

However, physical distancing of 2 meters (6 ft.) is still required between

parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household.

Due to the physical distancing requirement, most churches will not realize

any significant increase in capacity."

This means that Our Lady of Peace parish will continue to have

a limited number of parishioners for Mass in from Friday July 16, 2021.

Also, apart from the limited capacity, other COVID-19 safety protocols should be followed.

Parishioners should continue to wear masks at Mass and to sanitize

their hands before entering and leaving the church.
