Last September, at the weekend Masses on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>, one of the members of the parish's Finance Council came to give a short presentation about the two major maintenance problems we are experiencing: water leakage and the aging air conditioning system for the church. We have decided to set aside a reserve for replacement of the church air conditioning system, tentatively planned for spring 2022. We have received a quote of \$25,000.00 plus HST for the project. The reserve fund of \$27,800.00 will cover the current estimated costs. However, the quote does not include plans, permits or engineering fees for which additional funds may be required at the time of installation. The next major project will be to address the water leakage issues.

The Maintenance Fund has benefitted from several one-time donations and the generous, regular donations of our parishioners during this period. We thank you sincerely for your dedication to supporting Our Lady of Peace Parish.
