

THE SEASON OF LENT

The Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time (February 27) is the Sunday before Ash Wednesday (March 02). The celebration of Ash Wednesday ushers us into the Season of Lent. The Season of Lent leads us to Easter that begins with the celebration of Easter Vigil (April 16). The Season of Easter ends with the celebration of Pentecost June 05.
