

#### ASCENSION OF THE LORD - MAY 29, 2022

The spiritual significance of the celebration of Ascension of the Lord is our call to be missionary disciples. Pope Francis begins his 2013 Apostolic Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium (The Joy of the Gospel) with these words: "The joy of the Gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus." In this document the Pope encourages Christians to "embark upon a new chapter of evangelization marked by this joy, while pointing out new paths for the Church's journey in years to come". He calls Christians to be missionary disciples to proclaim the Good News. The Evangelist Luke has connected the Ascension event to the events of the resurrection and that of the giving of the Spirit. According to Luke, the Ascension can only be understood in the light of the giving of the Holy Spirit. The departure of Jesus to his Father came with Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit to guide us in our missionary activities. When we strive to share in the missionary activities entrusted to the first disciples, we joyfully bring the love of Christ to others.

#### PENTECOST SUNDAY - JUNE 5, 2022

On June 5<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate Pentecost Sunday traditionally referred to as the day of the birth of the Church and also when the gift of the Holy Spirit came to the Church.
