

Welcome Back

Our Lady of Peace Parish warmly welcomes parishioners back for the celebration of the Holy Eucharist. Our Lady of Peace welcomes visitors to the parish. Your physical presence here is a sign of life in our community. We are also happy to welcome our children back. Please remember that respecting provincial recommendations we do not come to church if we have a fever, cough, difficulty in breathing, sore throat or we are not feeling well.

Sunday Eucharist

The Eucharist remains the source and summit of our life in Christ. For Christians, participation in the Sunday Eucharist is the central experience of the week, and that is the foundation for the obligation of every Catholic to be personally present at Mass every Sunday. Of course, if there is a legitimate reason (such as being sick) this obligation does not apply. Similarly, when pandemic restrictions for the common good and love of neighbour have prevented attendance, then the obligation does not apply, and it is understandable as well, that some may feel hesitant at first about returning to personal participation. But as the restrictions are lifted, now is the time to encourage Catholics to return to physical presence at Sunday Mass, if not impeded for a legitimate reason, in keeping with our basic Sunday obligation as Catholics.

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY IUNE 12. 2022

In the Bible, we read that Jesus sent out his disciples to continue his ministry in all nations "baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19). The Christian concept of God as Trinity teaches that the Three Persons (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) share the same divine status.

As Christians, there is a tendency to regard the mystery of the Trinity as something remote and largely irrelevant in our lives. The celebration of Trinity Sunday encourages us to reflect on how we see the Trinity in our lives as people baptized in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. As baptized children of God, we share in the life of the Trinity who are in a relationship with each other-- a relationship based on love, peace, harmony and unity. As Christians, we are encouraged to imitate the loving relationship of the three Persons of the Trinity.

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

On Sunday June 19, 2022, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi* in honour of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. In 1264 Pope Urban IV instituted *Corpus Christi* for the Church-- for the faithful to draw a new strength from the Blessed Sacrament. On this *Corpus Christi* Sunday, we can therefore take the opportunity to reflect on how our participation in the Eucharist has shaped our Christian lives.

The Eucharist is the "Bread of life" that unites us to Christ (John 6:57) As people of the Eucharist, at Mass, we are all gathered from different backgrounds. But "we all partake of the one bread" (1 Corinthians 10:17), which symbolizes our unity in Christ as one community of faith. As we share the one bread, we also share the life of Christ. Today's celebration reminds us that as often as we eat this bread and drink the cup, we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes again (1 Corinthians 11:26). The Eucharist is a gift of God's love for us. Therefore, we celebrate the Eucharist with reverence, gratitude and a renewed desire to serve others.
