

# THE SEASON OF ORDINARY TIME LITURGICAL YEAR C

As we return from summer, we continue our faith journey through the Season of Ordinary Time of the Liturgical Year C. This Sunday September 4, is the Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Season of Ordinary Time is the longest of the Liturgical Seasons with thirty-four Sundays and weeks. The Thirty-Fourth Sunday is celebrated as the Solemnity of Christ the King. This year, the Solemnity of Christ the King will be celebrated on Sunday, November 20. Then a new Liturgical Year A begins with the Season of Advent. The First Sunday of Advent of Year A will be celebrated on November 27.

"The Liturgical Year is structured to help us celebrate and understand the spiritual significance of the mysteries of Jesus. During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. The Church encourages the faithful to participate in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist especially on Sundays which are Holydays of Obligation." The liturgical colour for Ordinary Time is green.
