### THE SEASON OF ORDINARY TIME LITURGICAL YEAR, YEAR C

The Season of Ordinary Time of the Liturgical Year, Year C is coming to an end in a couple of weeks' time. On Sunday, November 20, we celebrate the Thirty-Fourth Sunday-- the last Sunday in Ordinary Time as the Solemnity of Christ the King. The Thirty-Fourth week ends the Ordinary Time. A new Liturgical Year, Year A begins with the Season of Advent. The first Sunday of Advent is November 27, 2022.

"The Liturgical Year is structured to help us celebrate and understand the spiritual significance of the mysteries of Jesus. During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. The Church encourages the faithful to participate in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist especially on Sundays which are Holydays of Obligation."
