LAETARE SUNDAY-MARCH 19, 2023

The Fourth Sunday of Lent is referred to as *Laetare* Sunday or Rejoice Sunday. *Laetare* Sunday gets its name from the first words of the traditional Latin entrance antiphon for the Mass of the day: "Rejoice Jerusalem, and all who love her" (Isaiah 66:10-11). Traditionally this Sunday has been a day of celebration. As part of our celebration of this Rejoice Sunday, the rule of restricting flowers may be relaxed. Today, we may put some flowers around the altar. The priest's vestments at Mass may be rose coloured symbolizing joy. The Church celebrates hope and joy in the midst of our Lenten discipline.

The Gospel reading -The healing of a man born blind (John 9:1-41) together with the other two Biblical readings for today's liturgy remind us of the spiritual significance of Rejoice Sunday. Today, we are called to the joyful anticipation of the saving act of God in his Son Jesus Christ. Through Jesus' passion, death and his resurrection, God has brought us into a light of life. In baptism, we have moved from darkness into light. In baptism, we have become children of light. Lent is the special time to examine how we are living as people of light. As people of light, let us use our Lenten discipline to learn how to move away from darkness into light. During this Lenten journey, let us learn to move away from selfishness that blinds us to the needs of others, pride that blinds us to our own faults and prejudice that blinds us to the truth of the Gospel. Let us ask Jesus to teach us how to walk as children of light-"for the fruit of the light is found in all that is good and right and true" (Ephesians 5:9).
