

THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER - MAY 07, 2023

Easter: Living a purpose-filled life in the Risen Christ

Today our journey of life through the Easter Season brings us to the Fifth Sunday of Easter. In today's readings, we encounter stories of communities of faith in which believers lived a life that we can describe as a purpose-filled life in Christ. Through our baptism, our lives as members of a believing community should be Christ-centered (Acts 6:1-7; 1 Peter 2:4-9). In the Gospel reading (John 14:1-12), Jesus teaches us that his followers would enter into Jesus' own mission to make the Father known. Jesus also teaches us that his Father's house is where his followers would eventually come and see God the Father.

Whether we were baptized as babies, as children, young persons or adults, how would we describe the importance of our baptism in our lives? Today's readings tell us that communities of faith are built upon the relationship of members with Christ. The life in the community is to be based on the teachings of Christ. It is the way we live as members of communities of faith that provides us with the experience of the presence of God. To live a purpose-filled life in Christ calls us to live with our focus on Christ, the risen Christ, Christ becomes our focus when we live our lives in the spirit of the Gospel--sharing what we have with others, respecting the dignity of the personhood of others and supporting each other. Today, let us ask Jesus to renew within our hearts the spirit of our baptism. Let us ask him to teach us to live so that we may be welcomed into his Father's house, a place of welcome, abundance, peace, joy and love.
