

#### **HOMILY FOR TRINITY SUNDAY-JUNE 4, 2023**

The Christian Trinity: Living inspired lives

Today our journey of faith brings us to a very important celebration in the liturgical calendar--the celebration of Trinity Sunday. As part of the celebration, the Church has provided us with three readings (Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9; Responsorial Psalm-Daniel 3; 2 Corinthians 13:11-13; Gospel of John 3:16-18) to help us deepen our understanding of God, the God in whom we believe. When we examine the three readings, we can discern that the one God is identified as God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. The Bible teaches us that God is the Father--the Creator--who sent his Son Jesus Christ--the Messiah through him we have the gift of eternal life. The Holy Spirit--the third Person of the Trinity sustains us in our Christian faith. The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are so in tune with one another that they are actually one. The relationship between the three Persons is reflected in the harmony, peace and unity among them. The readings describe God as a God who is merciful, gracious, compassionate and faithful. He is a God of life and love. The relationship between the three Persons reflects the love, compassion and mercy for God's people. Today, as Christians, we are encouraged to enter into a loving relationship with the Trinity. It is when we live to reflect the mercy, compassion and the love of our God that the concept of one God in three Persons may be spiritually meaningful to us. Today, let us turn to the Triune God: God the Father who created us, Jesus, the Son who redeemed us and the Holy Spirit who renews us so that we live inspired lives in God's communities.
