<u>CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY - JUNE 11, 2023</u>

Finding manna in the wilderness

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Corpus Christi or the Body of Christ. Pope Urban IV established the Solemnity of Corpus Christi in 1264. The Pope established this feast at a time when the faith of the believers was decreasing. The celebration could offer a source of new strength that the faithful could draw from to help them become more virtuous. As part of our celebration, the Church has given us three readings (Deuteronomy 8: 2-3, 14-16; 1 Corinthians 10: 16-17 and Gospel of John 6:51-59) to help us reflect on and to renew our understanding of the meaning of Holy Communion in our lives as people who believe in Jesus Christ. Today's readings tell us that the celebration of Eucharist is deeply rooted in the long history of salvation. God saved the Israelites from hunger and death by providing them with manna--the bread from heaven. Jesus has become the bread from heaven to believers. Through Holy Communion, we are in communion with Jesus, a communion of life that transcends death and is forever. The sharing in the Body of Christ makes us one body--the Church. As members of one body, we live and function for one another. Today's celebration reminds us that to share in the Eucharist is to do for one another what Jesus does for us. In the Eucharist Jesus nourishes our lives. Therefore, we are encouraged to be the nourishment of the lives of others. We nourish the lives of one another through our respectful and compassionate actions based on Christ's love for us. Let us ask God to teach us how to be like manna in the wilderness for each other.
