I am the Good Shepherd

On the Fourth Sunday of Easter, known as Shepherd Good Sunday, we continue contemplation of the Resurrection's significance. This day also marks the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Today, we honor the risen Lord as the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His flock. The title "pastor" for the leader of a parish stems from its meaning: shepherd. In this role, the pastor guides, nourishes, comforts, corrects, and safeguards Christ's flock—the parishioners. Early Christians recognized Jesus as the fulfillment of the ancient Jewish hope for a Good Shepherd and sought to extend God's flock to include Gentiles.

In the first reading, Peter boldly declares before the Jewish assembly that salvation comes solely through Christ, the rejected and crucified Good Shepherd whom the apostles proclaim and heal in His name.

In the second reading, St. John illustrates how Yahweh, the Good Shepherd of the Old Testament, expressed His love by making us His children through His Son, Jesus, the Good Shepherd.

In today's Gospel, Jesus identifies Himself as the "Good Shepherd," claiming to know and love His sheep to the extent of being willing to die for them. The Gospel comforts us with the assurance that the Good Shepherd knows, provides for, and loves us. It also challenges us to both shepherd those under our care and be obedient sheep in Christ's fold.

Anyone entrusted with others' care is a shepherd—whether bishops, pastors, teachers, healthcare providers, or leaders. We fulfill this role by loving, praying for, sacrificing time and resources for, and protecting those in our charge. Parents, in particular, must set examples for their children by living exemplary lives.

Let us be obedient sheep in Christ's fold: a) By heeding our shepherds' guidance through their teachings, counsel, and advice. b) By partaking in nourishment through regular spiritual attendance, sacraments, prayer, and participation in parish activities. c) By supporting and cooperating with our pastors, offering feedback, encouragement, and gratitude for their ministry. d) By actively participating in parish initiatives and ministries as good stewards.

Let us pray for vocations. We pray for God's call to priesthood, diaconate, consecrated life, marriage, and singlehood, so that we may have more dedicated shepherds to lead and serve the Church. Jesus Christ embodies the ultimate Priest as the mediator between God and humanity, offering Himself as a unique sacrifice. The universal priesthood of believers, emphasized since Vatican II, underscores the shared priesthood in Christ among the baptized. On this World Day of Prayer for Vocations, we encourage and pray for young men to heed God's call to serve in the priesthood and for all of us to discern and fulfill our vocations according to His will.

This ensures that the pastor has the opportunity to become acquainted with you. The reference letter aims to confirm that the candidate is a practicing Catholic, actively participating in the parish community by regularly attending Sunday Mass. Please note that a request for a letter of reference may not be fulfilled if the pastor lacks sufficient familiarity with the individual making the request
