### **The Baptism of Our Lord**

The sacrament I hold most dear is baptism. It's always a joyous occasion when the birth of a child is celebrated and embraced, and in that moment, they are welcomed into a larger family the family of the Church. By being received into our church-family, these children become our brothers and sisters in Christ, sons and daughters of God, and temples of the Holy Spirit. The joy of faith and hope is tangible, especially when the parents and godparents bring the child to the baptismal font, where the celebrant pours water over their head. Before and after the baptism, the child is anointed with the special oils—the oil of catechumens and the oil of chrism. The baptismal garment is placed upon them, and the baptismal candle is lit. The entire event is uplifting in a way that is uniquely tied to this sacrament.

Most baptisms involve children who, of course, are unaware of what is happening. A significant decision is being made on their behalf, though they are not conscious of it. Just as parents make many important decisions for their children without consulting them, they joyfully make this profound decision on their behalf. In the Gospels, we read of parents bringing their little children to Jesus. When the disciples tried to stop them, Jesus rebuked them, saying, "Let the children come to me and do not stop them, for to such as these the kingdom of God belongs." Parents continue to bring their children to Jesus today when they present them for baptism, because, through baptism, these children are united with Christ. They become members of His body, and Jesus begins to live within them through the Holy Spirit. When parents bring their children for baptism, they are making a decision that aligns with the Lord's own desire: "Let the children come to me and do not stop them."

Today, we celebrate the feast of the baptism of Jesus, a perfect occasion to reflect on our own baptism and its significance in our lives. Jesus' baptism marked a pivotal moment in His life—a day of new beginnings. It was the start of His public ministry, during which He devoted Himself fully to serving God and all of God's people. On that day, He embarked on His mission to serve, not to be served, and to give His life as a ransom for many. As He began this profound journey for all of us, He was assured of the Father's favor: "You are

my Son, the Beloved; my favor rests on you." He was also empowered by the Holy Spirit, who descended upon Him like a dove.

While Jesus was baptized as an adult by John, and we are baptized as children, our baptism too marks a new beginning. On that day, we too began our journey of becoming disciples of Jesus in our own time. We received an assurance of God's love and favor, and we too were empowered by the Holy Spirit for the path ahead. In that moment, we were united with Jesus in His unique relationship with God, and we became members of His family—the Church. It was a moment of grace that holds the power to shape our lives in a fundamental way, in line with God's purpose for us.

In a sense, our entire lives are a journey to catch up with that initial day of new beginning. We are baptized as children, but it is as adults that we confirm our baptism. It is as adults that we make our own "yes" to the Lord, who said "yes" to us as children on the day of our baptism. This adult affirmation often comes later in life—perhaps in our late twenties, thirties, forties, or beyond—when we can fully respond with all our heart, soul, and mind. It is often in these mature years that we hear the call of Isaiah in today's First Reading: "O come to the water, all you who are thirsty; seek the Lord while He is still to be found, call to Him while He is still near."

The Lord calls to us from the moment of our baptism, and as the Lord says in the First Reading, "The word that goes from my mouth does not return to me empty, without carrying out my will and succeeding in what it was sent to do." Our response to the Lord's call may be slow, but His call remains powerful. His word is creative and will, in its time, shape us into what God desires for us.
