"YOU DID IT, DAD!"

In 1989, a devastating 8.2 magnitude earthquake struck Armenia, leveling buildings and claiming the lives of over 30,000 people in under four minutes. Just four minutes — that's all it took to reduce entire cities to dust, to silence thousands of voices, and to turn countless lives into chaos. It's hard to grasp the enormity of that kind of tragedy. But in moments of unimaginable heartbreak, the human spirit often rises. Sometimes, in the ruins, we see the purest forms of love, courage, and hope.

This is the story of one father's love — a love so fierce, it refused to quit. Amid the panic and destruction, this father raced to his son's school. But when he arrived, there was no school — only a mountain of debris. Can you imagine the terror, the helplessness? Around him, other parents wept and screamed their children's names, paralyzed by despair. But this father didn't stop. He couldn't.

Instead, he ran to the place where his son's classroom had been and started digging — bare hands, bleeding fingers, no tools, just sheer determination. Why? Because he had made a promise. "No matter what, I'll always be there for you." That promise kept him going, even when hope seemed impossible.

Others begged him to stop. "It's too late!" "They're all gone!" "You'll get yourself killed!" Even the fire chief and police tried to pull him away. But he wouldn't leave. He dug for 8... then 12... 24... 36 hours. And then — in the 38th hour — he moved a heavy piece of concrete and heard a sound. A voice. "**Dad**?" It was his son. Alive. Trapped. Waiting. And then came the words that broke the silence and echoed through the rubble: "I told them! I told the other kids that if you were alive, you'd come! You promised you'd always be there for me — and you did it, Dad!"

A promise kept. A son saved. Life pulled from the jaws of death. A stone rolled away to reveal hope. That story... it's powerful. But it points to an even greater one. Over 2,000 years ago, another Father made a promise. And just like Armand's dad, He kept it — at the cost of everything. On that first Easter, God rolled away a stone not just from a tomb, but from every heart that would believe. Through Jesus Christ, He made a way for us to live again — truly live — no matter what kind of rubble we're buried under.

What stones weigh you down? Is it despair, guilt, failure, addiction, grief? No matter how heavy, no matter how hopeless it may feel, our Heavenly Father is still in the business of rolling stones away. He's digging through the debris of broken lives and calling out, "I'm here. I've never left. I promised, and I'm keeping my promise."

Just like that father in Armenia, He won't stop until He finds you. Let this Easter be a reminder — or maybe a discovery — that God's love never gives up, never walks away, and never fails. The cross was His promise, and the empty tomb was His proof. Because of Jesus, sin is defeated, death is overcome, and life is yours — now and forever.

"But the one whom God raised from the dead did not see decay. Therefore, my friends, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you." — *Acts* 13:37-38

May you be filled with the hope of the resurrection and the unshakable love of the Father.
