Luke 10: 38-42

### **Martha and Mary**

The heart of today's readings beats with two powerful themes: the sacred call to true hospitality, and the need to pause and truly listen to God before we act. We see in Jesus the perfect host — welcoming the broken, the lost, the searching — and giving them not just food or shelter, but the very presence and mercy of God. The lesson is clear: the Christian life is about setting priorities. First and always, Christ at the center — then everything else finds its place.

In our first reading, Abraham and Sarah welcome three strangers with open hearts. They run to prepare the best meal they can offer. Their generous welcome turns into a miracle: the promise of a child when hope seemed gone. When we open our hearts and our homes to God's presence — whether in people or in prayer — the impossible can become possible. Hospitality isn't just an action; it's an act of faith that makes space for God to work wonders.

In the Gospel, we meet Martha and Mary, two sisters who loved Jesus deeply. Martha bustles in the kitchen, pouring herself out in service. Mary sits at Jesus' feet, soaking in every word. When Martha complains that Mary isn't helping, Jesus gently reminds her — busy hands are good, but only when guided by a listening heart. Martha's service was valuable, but Mary chose the "better part": to listen first. Service without prayer burns us out; prayer without service misses the point. One fuels the other. The Church grows when Marthas and Marys come together — when everyone finds a way to serve and to sit at the feet of Christ.

**Spend Time at His Feet.** Modern life is full of Marthas — the busy, the responsible, the hard workers. We need them! But even the busiest hearts must be recharged. Take time every day to sit with Jesus — in prayer, in Scripture, at Mass — and let Him speak to you. Without this daily pause, service becomes dry duty instead of joyful love.


**Be a Listening Martha and a Serving Mary.** We need action and contemplation together. The Church needs volunteers, families need caregivers, our communities need builders and healers. But all our doing must be rooted in prayer and reflection. Be a "contemplative in action," as St. Ignatius taught — hands at work, heart at rest in God.

**Listen at Home Too.** Hospitality starts not just with strangers but with those closest to us. Many homes are full of noise but empty of listening. Listen to your spouse, your children, your parents, your friends. Love begins with listening.

**Serve with Joy, Not Burnout.** Some of history's greatest contributions came from people who worked tirelessly — but also knew when to rest and refocus. If you give your best to work or hobbies, why not to God's mission too? Let every act of service be rooted in prayer, so it becomes grace, not grind.

**God's Gift to Us: The Meal of the Eucharist.** Every Sunday, God welcomes us to His table. The Mass is not about what we do for God but about what God does for us — He feeds us with His very self. Come to Mass not as a duty but as the greatest act of hospitality — God hosting us in His house. Come hungry, come grateful, come ready to be changed.

Today, be both Mary and Martha. Sit at Jesus' feet. Listen deeply. Then get up and serve with all your heart. When we welcome Him first, we find the strength to welcome and serve the world. And like Abraham, we may just find that when we open our door to God — miracles happen.
