

"Travel Light, Walk Through"

Our readings today speak about salvation—who will be saved, and how. They give us both a warning and a promise, and they call us to live with urgency and hope.

In the first reading, the prophet Isaiah reminds us that God's plan of salvation is not limited to one people or one nation. The Lord says, "I am coming to gather all nations and tongues, and they shall come and shall see my glory." What a beautiful vision! People from every corner of the earth—different languages, cultures, and backgrounds—all streaming toward God's holy mountain. No one is excluded. God's heart is wide, His mercy beyond measure.

But then the Gospel gives us a challenge. A man asks Jesus, "Lord, will only a few be saved?" Perhaps he wanted numbers, statistics, or guarantees. But Jesus does not answer in numbers. Instead He says: "Strive to enter through the narrow door."

Here is the heart of the message. Salvation is offered to everyone, but it is not automatic. It requires effort, perseverance, and choice. The narrow door is open, but it is not easy. It is the way of love, service, forgiveness, and humility. It is saying "yes" to God not only with our lips but with our lives.

Think about it: a door wide open requires no effort—you just walk in. But a narrow door means you cannot carry everything with you. You cannot squeeze through if you cling to pride, hatred, selfishness, or sin. You must let go. You must travel light, with a heart purified by love.

That is why Jesus warns: it is not enough to say, "We ate and drank with you; you taught in our streets." In other words, it is not enough to say, "I went to Mass, I knew about Jesus." What matters is whether we lived what we professed. Did I forgive? Did I serve? Did I allow God to change me?

Choose the narrow way each day. Every day presents choices: to forgive or to hold a grudge, to serve or to ignore, to tell the truth or to twist it, to pray or to neglect God. The narrow gate is choosing love even when it is hard.

Check your path regularly. At the end of each day, ask: "Did I walk toward God or away from Him today? Did I make room in my heart for Christ, or am I still weighed down by selfishness?" A short prayer of repentance and renewal can keep us ready.

Live with hope. The narrow gate is demanding, but we do not walk it alone. Christ Himself has gone before us. His grace strengthens us. And the promise remains: "People will come from east and west, from north and south, and will eat in the kingdom of God." If we persevere, we too will have a place at that banquet.

My friends, the message today is simple but urgent. Salvation is God's free gift, offered to all—but it requires our response. Let us not delay. Let us strive, each day, to walk through the narrow door of love, so that one day we may join the great feast of God's Kingdom with Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, the prophets, the saints—and with Christ our Lord forever.
