In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the Holy Spirit helps the apostles resolve a significant doctrinal issue about the Gentiles joining the Church, a challenge that shook the early community. The Responsorial Psalm prays that all nations recognize and praise God. The second reading, from the Book of Revelation, depicts the Church as the Heavenly Jerusalem, where the victorious Jesus resides, uniting all in love. The Gospel passage reminds us that the Holy Spirit, our Teacher and Advocate, is the source of peace and joy, guiding us with hope. Jesus promises that the Holy Spirit will teach us all we need to know.

The Holy Spirit guides us, prompting us to turn to Scripture for support, teaching us divine truths, and granting peace. To receive these gifts, we must spend time daily in prayer, listening to God, and growing in our relationship with Jesus. Through the Holy Spirit, we find solutions to life's challenges, love others, and maintain inner peace. The Holy Spirit teaches us through the Scriptures and Mass, and in Communion, we encounter Christ's love and peace.

In a world marked by isolation, where many live alone or disconnected, it's crucial to remember that Jesus is always with us. He replaces our burdens with joy, transforms our grief into peace, and fills our lives with purpose. By inviting Jesus into our hearts, we overcome loneliness and share His unity with others, bringing them closer to Him. As we celebrate the Eucharist, let us remember the price Jesus paid for our redemption and allow this celebration to empower us to live a true Life of the Spirit.

Frequently Asked Questions About the Diamond Jubilee Capital Campaign

- When do I need to return my pledge? As soon as possible. While we welcome future pledges, we hope to collect most pledges in the near term to move forward with the campaign.
- What if I can't meet my pledge obligation? Life happens. We understand that circumstances change, and there is no penalty for adjusting your pledge. We hope everyone can contribute as much as possible, but we are flexible if your situation shifts.
- **Can I designate my pledge for a specific project?** Yes! Simply note your preference on your pledge form, and we'll ensure your donation goes toward the project you feel most passionate about.
- Will I receive updates on how my pledge is used? Absolutely. We will provide regular updates on how the pledged funds are being utilized, ensuring complete transparency in how we fulfill the campaign's goals.
- Can I provide suggestions on how the funds are used? We welcome your ideas and feedback. While we cannot promise every suggestion will be implemented, we will make every effort to incorporate your valuable input.
- Why didn't Fr. Biju meet with me personally during the soft launch? Fr. Biju met with over 200 families during the initial stages of the campaign. However, with over 1000 registered families in our parish, it was not feasible for him to meet with everyone.
- **How long is the pledge period?** You can choose the duration that works best for you—whether a one-time donation or recurring payments over one, two, five, or up to ten years.
- What are the payment options? There are several convenient ways to contribute:
 - Cash: Drop off at the parish office or during Mass.
 - Cheque: Make cheques payable to "Our Lady of Peace" indicate DJCC on Cheque and drop them off at the office, mail them in, or place them in the offertory basket.
 - Credit Card: Pledge securely online using your credit card.
 - Pre-Authorized Debit: Set up automatic monthly contributions for a hassle-free experience.
 - **Securities and Shares**: Donations of stocks, bonds, or securities may offer tax benefits. Please contact the parish office for more information.

Frequently Asked Questions About the Diamond Jubilee Capital Campaign Continued

- Will I receive a tax receipt for my donation? Yes, all donations will receive a tax receipt for the actual amount given in each calendar year. Pledges will not be receipted until they are fulfilled, and receipts will be issued in February of the following year.
- What if I miss a payment? If you forget to make a payment, the campaign office will send you a reminder to help you stay on track.
- **Will my pledge be publicly disclosed?** No. Your pledged amount is confidential and will only be shared with the Finance Council and accounting staff.
- **How much does it cost to run this campaign?** The total cost to run this campaign is just \$3,000, primarily for printing campaign materials.


