### **COMING TO CHURCH DURING THIS SUMMER**

We are in Step 3 of the Roadmap for Re-Opening plan for Ontario. There is no capacity limit for places of worship. However, physical distancing of 2 meters (6 ft.) is still required between parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household. Due to the physical distancing requirement, most churches will not realize any significant increase in capacity. This means that Our Lady of Peace parish will continue to have a limited number of parishioners for Mass.

Also, all other COVID-19 safety protocols should be followed. Parishioners should continue to wear masks at Mass and to sanitize their hands before entering and leaving the church. Doors are opened 30 minutes before Mass.

#### THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION

#### **OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY AUG 15, 2021**

On Sunday, August 15, 2021 the Church celebrates the day that Mary, the Mother of Jesus was taken up body and soul into heaven at the end of her earthly life. When a Solemnity falls on a Sunday in Ordinary Time, the celebration replaces the celebration of that Sunday. Therefore, today's celebration of the Solemnity of the Assumption replaces that of the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

The Solemnity of the Assumption is one of the four Solemnities in honour of Mary. The other three are the Divine Motherhood of Mary on January 1, the Annunciation of the Coming of the Lord by the Angel Gabriel on March 25 and the Immaculate Conception of Mary on December 8. At Our Lady of Peace, each of these Solemnities in honour of Mary is special to us because our parish is named after the Blessed Mother. Mary's Assumption means that she shares in her Son's victory over death and enjoys the fullness of eternal glory.

As Christians, today's celebration reminds us that the bodily glorification of Mary is the anticipation of our own glorification at the end of time. Today's celebration is a message of hope and encouragement for us. We are on a journey of faith towards God. The Blessed Mother's Assumption reminds us to strive to live as people of God. Let us ask Jesus, the Son of Mary to lead us to his kingdom of peace and light.
