## **Christ Our Light: Called to Repent, Called to Follow**

Today's Scripture readings proclaim a powerful and hope-filled truth: Christ has brought us into the Light. That Light is not an idea or a philosophy—it is a Person. Jesus enters the dark places of history, society, and the human heart, calling us to repentance, unity, and a transformed way of life.

The prophet Isaiah speaks to a people who knew darkness well—war, occupation, fear, and loss. Into that reality comes God's promise: "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." Matthew deliberately places this prophecy at the beginning of Jesus' public ministry to make one thing unmistakably clear: Jesus is that Light. What Isaiah foresaw has now been fulfilled. Darkness does not have the final word. God does.

The Responsorial Psalm gives voice to our response: "The Lord is my Light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?" When the Lord becomes our refuge, fear loses its grip. The Light of God does not merely brighten our circumstances—it gives us courage, direction, and hope, even when life feels uncertain or overwhelming.

Saint Paul, writing to the divided community in Corinth, reminds us that people who live in the Light must also live in unity. Rivalries, factions, and ego-driven loyalties are signs that Christ's Light has been dimmed by pride. Christ cannot be divided, and neither can His Body, the Church. To live as children of the Light means choosing humility over competition, communion over division, and Christ over every lesser attachment.

The Gospel according to Matthew shows us how this Light enters the world. After the arrest of John the Baptist, Jesus begins His ministry in Galilee—a region considered insignificant, mixed with Gentiles, and long marked by political and spiritual darkness. It is precisely there, among the marginalized and the forgotten, that Jesus chooses to dwell. He proclaims a simple but demanding message: "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven has come near."

Repentance, as Jesus understands it, is far more than feeling sorry for past sins. It is metanoia—a radical change of mind and heart, a decisive turning away from self and toward God. It is an ongoing way of life. To repent is to surrender control, to admit that we cannot save ourselves, and to allow God to re-create us from within. Repentance is not weakness; it is the doorway to freedom.

Immediately after this call, Jesus invites ordinary fishermen—Peter and Andrew, James and John—to follow Him. He does not choose scholars, elites, or the powerful. He chooses working men with calloused hands and open hearts. They leave their nets at once—not because they know where the road will lead, but because they trust the One who calls them. What Jesus needs is not our ability, but our availability.

To be made "fishers of people" means allowing ourselves first to be caught in the net of God's love—dying to self so that God may raise us to new life. It means stepping out of old patterns, old fears, and old securities, and entering the Kingdom that is already near. Eventually, Jesus will say to His followers, "You are the light of the world." He chooses us so that His Light may continue to shine through us.

Matthew summarizes Jesus' mission in three words: teaching, preaching, and healing. These are not relics of the past; they are the ongoing mission of the Church today. Through God's Word, hearts are changed. Through the Good News, lives are healed. Through loving service, the darkness of injustice, prejudice, violence, and despair is pushed back.

Appreciate your call as a disciple. Every baptized person is personally called by Christ and sent as part of His Church. Through the Sacraments, God continually strengthens, heals, and reclaims us when we wander. Our faith is not private—it is lived for the life of the world.

Proclaim the Good News by word and witness. Like the first disciples, we are asked to leave behind our "nets"—self-centeredness, comfort, indifference—and to rebuild our homes, workplaces, and communities with justice, mercy, and peace.

Become light in a dark world. Even a small flame dispels darkness. When we live with kindness, forgiveness, humility, and respect for others—especially those different from us—we become beacons of Christ's presence.

## **Marian Pilgrimage - Diamond Jubilee Special**
