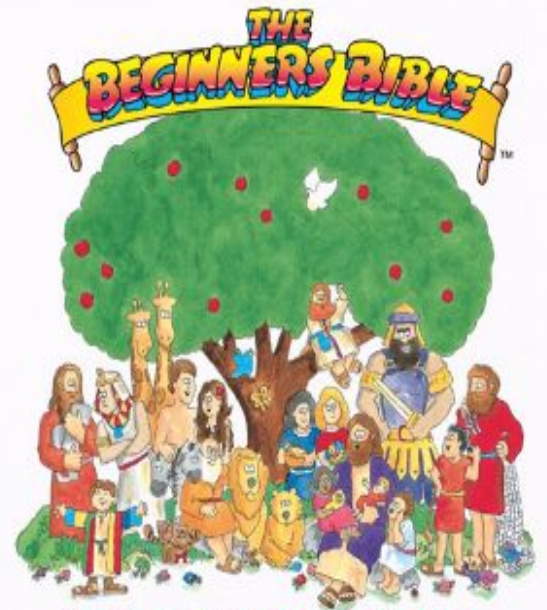

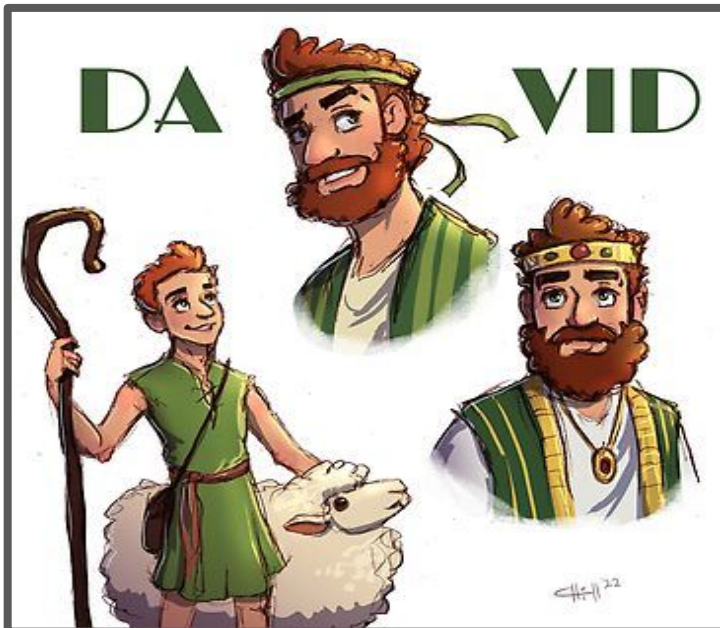

What is this?

This year's summer camp is all about the wonderful and exciting stories & characters from the Old Testament of the Bible. Through these stories & activities, we will learn more about our spiritual history, and the amazing works of God from the past.

Camp runs from July 22nd to 26th, from 9:30am to 3:00pm daily

Where is it?

Campers will come to the OLP parish hall beneath the church and sign in daily. We are located at: 3914 Bloor St. West, Etobicoke, ON, M9B 1L7

What's the cost?

The registration cost per child is \$120, with additional children able to be registered at a discounted cost of \$80. This pricing reflects the affordability compared to other typical camps, as well as contributes to the cost for camp materials, snacks and a pizza lunch for Friday the 26th. We are currently at a limit of 60 spots on a first come-first serve basis, so don't delay!

What are we doing?

The activities range from day to day, but will typically include; reading & storytelling from the Bible, educational videos (from the Bless-ed catalogue), arts & crafts, group games, skits & much more, all in the comfort of the OLP hall.

What to bring:

- Dress for the summer weather; comfortable & church appropriate (no vulgarity on clothing etc.)
- Personal lunch for Monday - Thursday
- small bag or backpack to take home completed activities

Optional:

- notebook and pencil/pen for taking notes
- colouring pencils/crayons

What NOT to bring:

- valuables, jewellery etc.
